A panel of HyFlex enthusiasts will discuss the future of assessment and feedback in HyFlex. The panelists are Mel Young from Cambrian College, Dr. Cathy Littlefield from Pierce College, and Dr. Kevin Kelly from San Francisco State University. The panel will be moderated by Linda Facchini Professor in Seneca's Teaching & Learning Centre.

Dr. Beatty will return in the afternoon for a fireside chat.
