

## Adding a Course Banner

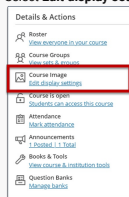

Adding a banner to your course is a great way to add visual flare.

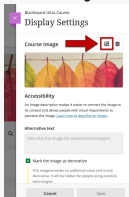

## Adding a Course Banner

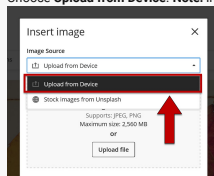
1. Select **Edit display settings** from the **Details & Actions** pane. Course Image panel is displayed.



2. Select the **Image icon**.



- a. Choose **Upload from Device**. **Note:** Image must be at least 1200 x 240 pixels. Images with text don't scale well.



- b. Choose **Stock images from Unsplash**. **Note:** If you want to learn more about this option then check out [Choosing a Course Image \(Banner\)](#).

3. Complete one of the following actions:

- If the image is decorative, select **Mark as decorative**. Content marked as decorative won't provide descriptions to screen readers.



- If the image is informative, input the description of the image into the **Alternative text** box.
