


Exporting a Course Package

Once you have finished creating your course content, you can export the course to a .zip file for your own records, or to easily re-create the course shell in the future.


Exporting A Course Package

1. Select the course you want to export.
2. Select **Content** from the top menu bar.





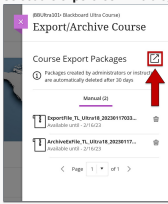

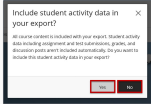

5. Select the **export icon**. A dialogue box prompting you to choose if you want to export student data is displayed.

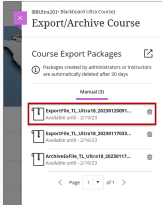


6. Complete one of the following tasks:



- Select **Yes** to export student data and class content.
- Select **No** to export only course content.

7. Select the **.zip file** under **Course Export Packages** to download the file. **Note:** Exported packages are automatically deleted from this panel after 30 days of their initial export.



Note: Ensure that your browser does not open files on download automatically or else the .zip file will be converted into a folder, making it difficult to import it back into Blackboard later.
