
BB Ultra Transition Steps and Notes

Download a PDF version of the steps.



(text, images, video, web links, discussion board, assessment).

You can move these up and down by dragging each.

You can edit content in each (add, delete, change). You can add additional elements.

- Any links to outside sites should be checked and updated (for example a link to Zoom or Big . Blue Button within Blackboard needs to be updated),
- The link to many of the video links may be unlinked. All of your videos uploaded to Blackboard are in the contents area for the course. Videos on Youtube and other cloud sites have to be linked again,
- Some images might have changed in size. Resize and take the opportunity to add alternate

Look at the assessments and arrange appropriately.

Click **Calendar** (top of screen) and add all deliverable or significant event dates for the course section.

Click Discussions and add posts as required.

Click **Gradebook** and arrange items as required (adding an assessment in the Course Content area automatically puts the item in Gradebook).



There is a separate main video and multiple targeted videos about this topic.



This is your chance to fine tune your work. Reflect on who your learner is now (generations, mental health, ethnicity, learning styles).

Consider the pedagogical (andragogical) impact of what you do in BB Ultra. Images, videos, presentation and sequencing of information, access to tools and live collaboration tools.

Make sure that all material, especially images and videos are accessible (<u>AODA</u> and <u>UID</u>). Add tags or alternate texts, closed captioning and make sure that colours are appropriate and visible.

Consider adding consistent PDF documents with transcripts or descriptions of media content. Always put the title and short description of a WWW link above the link itself.
