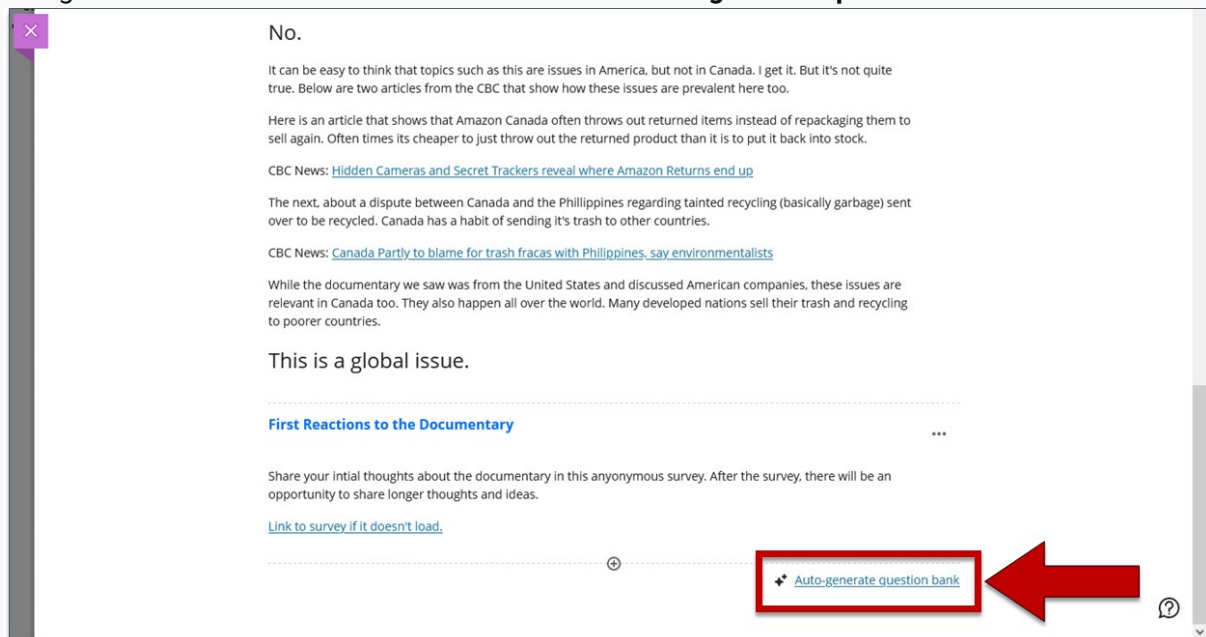

The AI Design Assistant can generate a question bank based on a Learn@Seneca Blackboard Ultra Document.

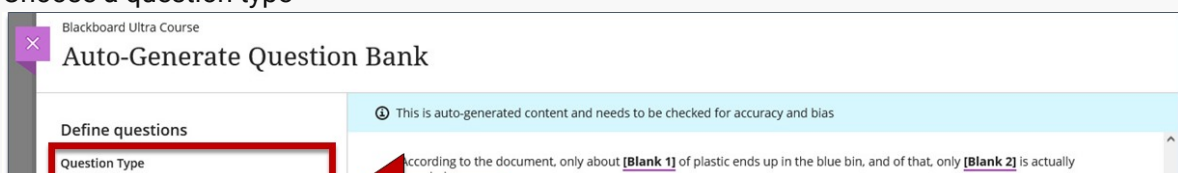
Generating a Question Bank from a Learn@Seneca Blackboard Ultra Document

1. Select the Document you want to create a Question Bank from.
2. Navigate to the bottom of the Document and select **Auto-generate question bank**.



3. You can choose from the generated questions or you can add more information in the Define questions pane:

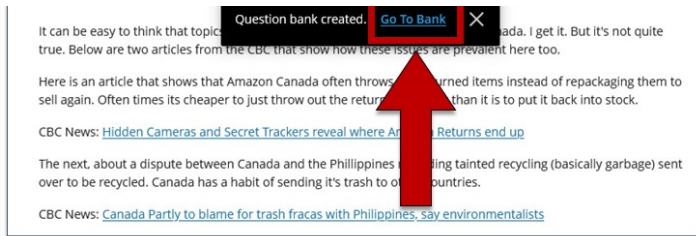

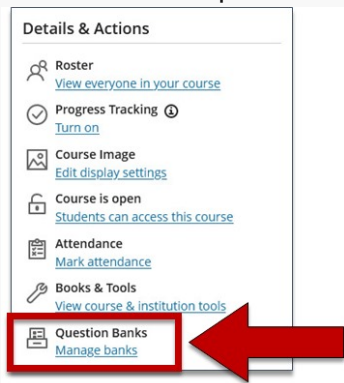
5. A notification will pop up notifying you that the question bank was created. Navigate to that question bank. There are two ways to get there:

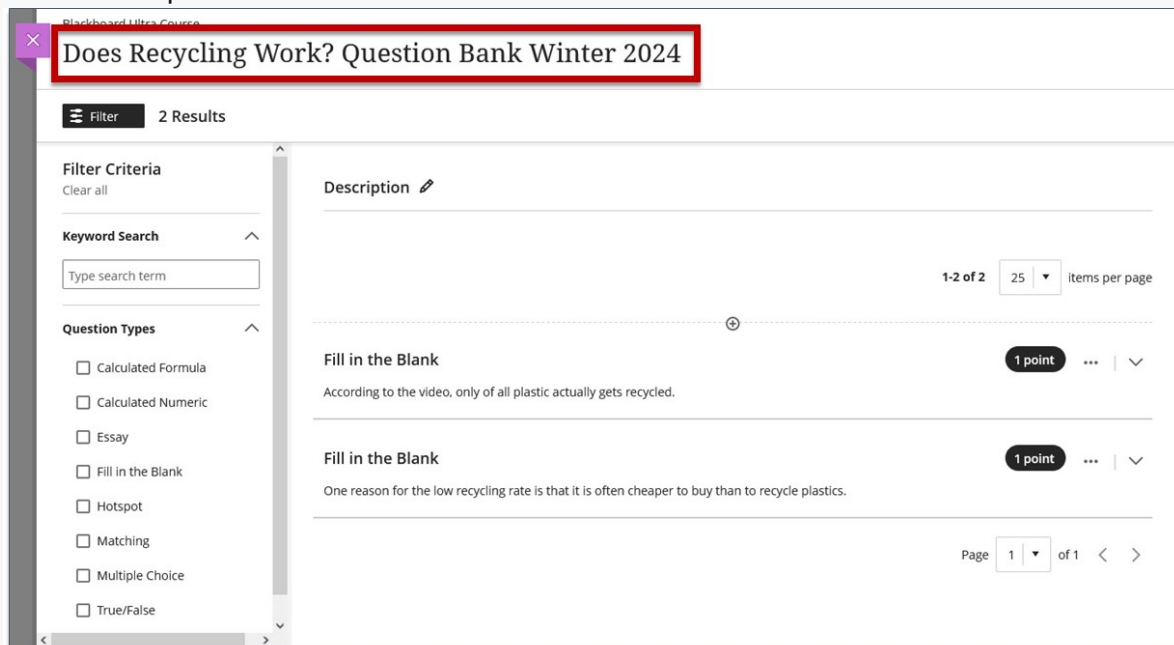


- b. Close the document, return to the Course Content page, and select **Manage banks** from the Details & Actions pane.
