Lockdown Browser

On a Seneca Lab computer (the ones in our class), login to myapps.senecapolytechnic.ca. Search for "lockdown" and launch "Respondus LDB" (the first icon).

Once the app launches, close it.

On a browser (e.g. chrome / edge), log into Learn@Seneca and navigate to the Test (use "sample test" to practice).

When prompted, allow it to open Respondus.

This will allow you to attempt the test.
