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Supporting Students as They Prepare for Upcoming Tests

1. Encourage Students to Begin Preparing Early

- Remind students to review weekly notes, complete practice questions, and attend any review sessions.
- Share study tips or short check-ins to help them focus on key concepts.
- Share the assessment or test formats or expectations via Blackboard announcements.

2. Important: Students With Accommodations
