If you haven't heard, Seneca has entered a [partnership with Microsoft](#). This means many things, but one thing is for sure – The Teaching & Learning Centre is now certified to run Microsoft Learn for Educators (MSLE) AI Bootcamps.

### What is an MSLE AI Bootcamp?

These interactive workshops are ideal for Seneca faculty and instructors who are relatively new to AI and would like to learn the basics of how to use AI effectively and safely in their own teaching practice.
