The [OneCard](#) is the official Seneca College identification card. It's also a chip-enabled convenience card with a number of features. Use it to pay for parking plans, meals, photocopying and printing. It's also needed to use the campus bus service and at Seneca libraries. The OneCard is password (PIN) protected, making it financially secure for

employees and students to use when purchasing services on campus.
