

 - Setting Up Accommodations and Setting Exceptions for Tests and Assignments
 Accommodations allow for students to submit work past deadlines or receive extra
 time for timed tests. These accommodations impact all due dates and/or timed
 activities.

Exceptions are specific to an assignment and allow the instructor to change the due date, visibility dates, or number of attempts for a specific student. Students can view changes such as extensions in their calendar.
