## **Course Assessments Surveys**

Through the My.Seneca platform, an online survey tool is used to obtain student feedback on your effectiveness in the classroom. Each full-time professor is surveyed once per year in the Fall semester. Probationary and contract faculty are evaluated both in the Fall and Winter semesters. This survey is distributed through the student's My.Seneca Learn@Seneca account for completion.

The survey results will be forwarded electronically to you, and to your Chair approximately two months later.

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
