In the previous issue of the *Academic Newsletter* (Winter 2017; Education Technology Advisory Committee), Laurel Schollen introduced the new Educational Technology Advisory Committee (ETAC). ETAC is one of the of the (ACC) and acts in an advisory capacity to the ACC on the use of technology to enhance teaching and learning (among other things).

As the ETAC Chair, I wanted to give you an update on the committee make-up and activities. Membership is just about set and comprises six faculty, two Chairs, and one member each from Information Technology Services (ITS), the Centre for Flexible Learning (cFLEX), and Counselling and Accessibility Services (CnAS).
