Microsoft Teams is a collaborative, communication tool contained in the Office 365 platform available to all Senecans. Be aware that only employees have the capacity to create a Teams site. Teams allows online collaborative meeting capacity, access to IMS via chat, the ability to share files and members can create a shared OneNote notebook.

It is intended for quick use of free or low-cost online tools and not for larger, more costly tools that require more rigorous data privacy vetting.
